Philippians 3:1 – 11 (ESV)

Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you is no trouble to me and is safe for you. 2 Look out for the dogs, look out for the evildoers, look out for those who mutilate the flesh. 3 For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh— 4 though I myself have reason for confidence in the flesh also. If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: 5 circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; 6 as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless. 7 But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. 8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith— 10 that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, 11 that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

- Guard Against False Teachers Vs. 1 – 3

Galatians 2:21, I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!

Galatians 5:12, As for those agitators, I wish they would go the whole way and emasculate themselves!

Galatians 3:7, 13-14, Understand, then, that those who have faith are children of Abraham. 13, Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole.” 14 He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

Are you on guard against false teachers?

- Rejection of atonement
- Jesus was not God in the Flesh
- Jesus was just a good example for us to follow
- Jesus is not the only way of salvation or never claimed He was. (John 14:6, Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.)
- Admitting you are a sinner in need of a Savior

- Believing Jesus the perfect Son of God, died on the cross to pay the price for Sin (That's Atonement) and rose from the grave
- Choosing to place your faith in Him alone for Salvation

- Self-Righteousness is Rubbish Vs. 4 – 8

Philippians 3:7-8 (NLT), I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done. 8 Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ

- Righteousness from Faith in Christ is the Greatest Value Vs. 9 – 11
