JOHN 12:1-11John 12:1 Mary Anoints Jesus at Bethany

- The Return of the Resurrector, Vs. 1 – 3

John 12: 1 – 3, Six days before the Passover, Jesus therefore came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom Jesus had raised from the dead. 2 So they gave a dinner for him there. Martha served, and Lazarus was one of those reclining with him at table. 3 Mary therefore took a pound of expensive ointment made from pure nard, and anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume.

John 20:30-31, Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

For Martha, Her worship and thankfulness look like service.

Mark 10:43-45, But it shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, 44 and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. 45 For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

1 Peter 4:9-10, Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. 10 As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace:

For Mary, Her worship and thankfulness looks like sacrifice.

Application: How do we worship the resurrector of our soul?

- The Baffled Betrayer, Vs. 4 – 6

John 12: 4 – 6, But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples (he who was about to betray him), said, 5 “Why was this ointment not sold for three hundred denarii and given to the poor?” 6 He said this, not because he cared about the poor, but because he was a thief, and having charge of the moneybag he used to help himself to what was put into it.

Matthew 26:14-16, Then one of the twelve, whose name was Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests 15 and said, “What will you give me if I deliver him over to you?” And they paid him thirty pieces of silver. 16 And from that moment he sought an opportunity to betray him.

Application: Are you a phony like Judas?

- Call to Pursue Christ, Not a Cause Vs. 7 – 8

John 12:7 – 8, Jesus said, “Leave her alone, so that she may keep it for the day of my burial. 8 For the poor you always have with you, but you do not always have me.”

Application: If you are pursuing Jesus, don't worry about what someone else says.

- The Plotting of the Priests, Vs. 9 – 11

John 12:9 – 11, When the large crowd of the Jews learned that Jesus was there, they came, not only on account of him but also to see Lazarus, whom he had raised from the dead. 10 So the chief priests made plans to put Lazarus to death as well, 11 because on account of him many of the Jews were going away and believing in Jesus.

Application: How are you going to Respond to Jesus?
