Transition:

Even when we may not see it, we can trust that God is Sovereignly at Work.

Moses' Doubts are Answered Vs. 1 – 17

D.L. Moody on Moses.

“Moses spent his first forty years thinking he was somebody. He spent his second forty years learning he was a nobody. He spent his third forty years discovering what God can do with a nobody.”

Exodus 4:10-12, But Moses pleaded with the Lord, “O Lord, I’m not very good with words. I never have been, and I’m not now, even though you have spoken to me. I get tongue-tied, and my words get tangled.” 11 Then the Lord asked Moses, “Who makes a person’s mouth? Who decides whether people speak or do not speak, hear or do not hear, see or do not see? Is it not I, the Lord? 12 Now go! I will be with you as you speak, and I will instruct you in what to say.”

Moses’ ability to speak does not supersede God’s ability to cause people to hear.

Application: How do you answer doubts?

1 Corinthians 1:27, But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong.

As Moses follows in faith, God fills in the gaps Vs. 18 – 23

Application: In what ways have you followed the Lord in faith?

Even Moses was not above the law Vs. 24 – 26

Application: Has the wrath of God been satisfied in your life?

Romans 5: 6 – 10, You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. 7 Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. 8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! 10 For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!
